What you need to do

- Sign in to Tax Pro Account at irs.gov/tax roaccount.
- Associate your CAF number to our person, I information by entering the PIN number.

What you should now about your PIN

- It is for one-time use only and will expire in 30 days.
- It is unique to this CAF number.
- It can ally be used to verify ownership of your CAF number in Tax Pro Account.
- It is or your use only. Don't share it with anyone.

What you should know about keeping your PIN secure

The IRS doesn't contact taxpayers or tax professionals by email, text message or social media to request personal or financial information. This includes requests for PIN numbers, passwords or similar access information for credit cards, banks or other financial accounts.
